
Thank you Jason and welcome Isabella, Pastor Polly



CHUMC History 1980 - 1990 - The Existing Sanctuary is Built!

We built the existing sanctuary and took occupancy in 1980. Building of the sanctuary required that the committee create ways to reduce the overall cost of the building to stay within the allowed budget. Problem to overcome was that our resident architects felt like we had to remove 30% of the normal cost. The committee of about 18 church members and staff took the challenge! They were able through the efforts of a seasoned architect to keep the building within budget. As II recall, we had about eight dollars and change left in the budget when completed. The remainder of this time was devoted primarily to building church growth and continuing our Spiritual Journey. At this point in our congregation we were having three worship services on Sunday morning, and our congregation approached the ultimate high of about 2500 people on our church roll! CHUMC had a tremendous children, youth and adult Sunday school effort, and Sunday school classrooms became scarce.
